OFDNA board members present: Nan Loveland, Laura McCoy, Kathy Henderson, Lewis Hollander, Leslie Perry, and Shirley Walkey. Also present - Transportation Chair Mark Schindel.

July minutes approved.

## Reports

- 1) Mark – Spoke about a hearing for Pahlisch Homes subdivision on 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Mark Nan and Daryl all attended. Originally they were going to put in a right turn lane at 15<sup>th</sup> and Reed Market Road but that doesn't make sense now because there will be a round-about there eventually. The City is trying to get Pahlisch to pay \$43,000 towards the round-about plus put in a right turn lane. Pahlisch objected and said it should be one or the other, not both. The City is now trying to get a consortium together to help pay for improvements to the area.

TSA Committee meeting – The City Council wants to amend the resolution to:

- A) Reduce staff participation on committee
  - B) Reword purpose of committee to traffic safety and moving goods & providing services. The council voted 4 – 3 to change focus from safety onto movement. Mark feels that the NA's concerns about safety will still be addressed.
  - C) 97 / 20 refinement plan will connect Empire to 27<sup>th</sup> Street which will affect our neighborhood.
- 2) Fall meeting will be at Jewell Elementary in the cafeteria September 28<sup>th</sup>.
  - 3) Our OFDNA banners are in and look good.
  - 4) Basic Village (178 homes) will now have a 2-1/2 acre park.
  - 5) There was a discussion of Anderson Fields Subdivision at 15<sup>th</sup> and Reed Mkt. Rd. Amy Barry is planner to contact with questions and concerns.
  - 6) Eloisa sent budget information. Our banners did not show up on the June budget. Nan will find out where the money to pay that \$150 will come from.
  - 7) Southeast Neighborhood Association (SENA) will have its first meeting on September 14 at the fire hall on Country Club Drive.
  - 8) At the City Council meeting the tree ordinance was still unresolved. The question is - what does the ordinance mean to accomplish?
  - 9) Good Samaritan program and a traffic questionnaire will be topics at the fall meeting.
  - 10) We have \$378 in our bank account.
  - 11) General meeting notices have to be in the mail by September 14<sup>th</sup>.

Next meeting – September 12<sup>th</sup> at Nan's house since nobody can make the 21<sup>st</sup>.
